**Attempt all the cases. Each case carries 5 marks. Preferable length of each case may be one to one and a half pages.**

1. “Man is born free and everywhere he is in chains. The world of reality has its limits; the world of imagination is boundless. You forget that the fruits belong to all and that the land belongs to no one.” Based on this quotation given by J.J Rousseau, critically assess the influence of French Philosophers for the French Revolution of 1789.
2. “Not through speeches and majority decisions will the great questions of the day be decided—that was the great mistake of 1848 and 1849—but by iron and blood” Based on this famous quote of Votto Von Bismark, analyse the strategic move taken by him for the materialisation of the task of German unification.
