### Paper XI- Project Management in Health Care

1. Discuss the significance of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for a hospital project.
2. Explain with an example how to monitor and control the implementation of a project in a hospital.
3. Explain the different types of project organization. Give suitable examples.

### Paper XII – Hospital House Keeping

1. “The correct incorporation of ergonomics into the hospital can bring true cost saving”. Discuss this point with examples. Your answer should have details regarding relationship between human factors and patient safety in hospital settings.
2. “Studies conducted on patient satisfaction by various authorities have clearly established the lack of sanitation and cleanliness as important dissatisfaction attributes”. Discuss the emerging issues pertaining to house-keeping services in hospitals.
3. Explain the importance of Central Sterile Supply Department (CSSD) of a hospital. Prepare a detailed proposal for setting up a CSSD for a 500 bedded hospital in a city. Your answer should have details of aim, objectives, functions, layout, location particulars and budget for setting up a state-of-the-art facility.

### Paper XIII - Emerging Trends in Health Care Management

1. National Health Service (NHS) in England is one of the world's largest publicly funded health services. Find out how it operates in England and discuss about any upcoming changes.
2. “Gender inequality refers to socially constructed differences between men and women that systematically empower one group to the detriment of the other”. Discuss this issue in terms of economic inequalities, educational inequalities, health and survival inequalities. Elaborate the reasons for gender inequalities?
3. Discuss the current epidemiological situation of HIV/AIDS in India. Elaborate Information, Education & Communication (IEC) activities targeted for prevention and management of HIV/ AIDS.
